### Bribery

What is bribery? This means to offer money or some other good to a person who is not duty bound to do what you say to do a job for you. Bribery happens in society in a small-large scale without you knowing it! Small bribes can be something like doing a person's homework or helping them in a test or such for something in your favorite online game, or for something similar. It is wrong to accept such bribes, but these are somewhat harmless at this level. But if it is taken even slightly higher then it is a criminal offence.

Suppose you are a Restaurant owner and you are dining at the Restaurant that rivals you, and you secretly give the waiter serving you money to entice him into sabotaging the place's kitchen. That can land you in jail if you or anyone associated in the bribing is caught for 1 year or so with or without paying a fine. Bribing is like taking a gamble. The person motivated by Greed/Fear may take the bribe and do the job. OR they could report you for attempted bribing and you land in jail. If any bribe, no matter if it's as small as helping someone in a test for something, to as big as an incident in the government because of a bribe which influenced the history of that place, all bribing attempts must be reported to the one in charge i.e. you class teacher or if it's something big like the latter example then the authorities. Bribing was made illegal as part of the prevention of corruption act (NO.49 of 1988) and was enforced on 9th September 1988. This goes to show how bribing is dangerous and can change history, and why all attempts must be rejected and reported. I hope this was informative and helped clear any doubt regarding the term 'bribing'.
